OVERVIEW

This qualification provides entry level skills and knowledge for an individual to enter the transport and logistics industry – multiskilling in chain of responsibility, receive and store goods, complete workplace documentation and provide support to the team in NSW.

This course can be delivered in a flexible program of classroom training and self-paced learning activities.

QUALIFICATION CONTENT

Participants will need to complete eleven (11) units of competency, four (4) core units and seven (7) elective units for this qualification.

Keep in mind, one of our ARC representatives will be happy to discuss unit selection, recognition of prior learning and credit transfer.

Entry Requirements:

There are no entry requirements for this qualification. Student will be required to provide their USI and complete a language, literacy and numeracy test.

Where will the training take place?

Training and Assessment will take place:

Classroom – Training and assessment takes place in a classroom and involves discussions and activities.

Self-directed learning – read and study course material, research and review assessment in their own time.

Assessment – assessment may include written questions, scenarios and observations.

What ARC Training provides?

We provide learning materials, assessment tools and a qualified trainer and assessor.

How long will the program run?

Students have up to 6 months to complete the course.

How much will it cost?
