OVERVIEW

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge for an individual to operate across a broad range of activities within the logistics industry – multiskilling in receiving, handling and dispatching stock coming into, or going out of stores or warehouses and chain of responsibility in NSW.

This course can be delivered in a flexible program of classroom training and self-paced learning activities.

QUALIFICATION STRUCTURE

Participants will need to complete fifteen (15) units of competency, two (2) core units and thirteen (13) elective units for this qualification. Please see the next page for our standard TLI42016 Certificate IV in Logistics

Where will the training take place?

Training and Assessment will take place:

Classroom: Training and assessment takes place in a classroom and involves discussions and activities.

Self-directed learning: Read and study course material, research and review assessment in their own time.

Assessment: Assessment may include written questions, scenarios and observations.
